No camper arrivals after dark.

Reservation Policies

- Early check-ins are based on availability at the time. Call our office at 715-379-2942 to check availability of early check in or late check outs.
- Rates are based on one family. (2 adults and 2 children)
 \$5.00 extra per person per day for 3 or more adults per site.
- Each Reservation includes 1 camping unit.

 Adding an additional tent to your site requires an additional fee. If you would like to add a tent to your site, please contact the office and provide registration information for the tent occupants. Additional tents are \$35 per night.
- All campers must have valid license and registration
- The campsite must be registered with occupant's name upon check-in.

Payment Policy

- All campers must have a valid credit on file, regardless of payment method.
- All reservations are charged a non-refundable deposit of \$20.00
- Seasonal reservations are charged a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00
- Seasonal rates are available until June 1st.
- There are no refunds for early departure

Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations will not receive a refund of the deposit.
- No shows will be charged the full reservation amount.

Campground Rules

NO REFUNDS FOR EARLY DEPARTURE

- Garbage should be placed in the dumpsters located at the north end of the park. DO NOT PUT YOUR TRASH IN THE BATHROOM TRASH CANS.
- The women's bathroom is closed daily from 0700-0800 for cleaning and disinfection.
 Please plan accordingly. The disinfectant needs to air dry so the restrooms will be wet after disinfection.
- Do not put grills or smokers on our tables. The tables are plastic...grills are hot...
- Children must be supervised at all times. Unsupervised children who cause disruption for other guests may be asked to leave along with their entire party.
- Please respect the privacy of other guests. Do not walk through occupied sites.
- No smoking in the buildings. Dispose of butts properly.
- NO FIREWORKS
- · No clotheslines are allowed in the park.
- Leave the campsites as you found them. Unkempt sites may be subject to cleaning and trash disposal fees. This applies to seasonal guests that leave blocking, trash, pipes, or any other mess, as well.
- SPEED LIMIT IN THE PARK IS 5MPH! Please be aware of pedestrians and animals in the roadway.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. No outdoor radios, tv or speakers allowed.
 Curfew is 10:00 pm. All children under the age of 18 are required to be back at their site by 10:00 pm.
- Golf carts are not permitted after 10:00pm
- Cleanliness of the park is important to us. Sites are to be kept clean and orderly. Please leave the restrooms as you would like to find them.
- We do not allow the washing of tow vehicles, there are several car washes nearby.
- Trailers, boats, pontoons, etc. must be parked in the trailer area.
- Car dollies are allowed on the campsite for overnight and weekly guests only. All other must park in the trailer lot.

Mowing Operations

Please be aware of mowing operations. Give mowers room or leave the area. In order
to keep the park in excellent condition for all our campers to enjoy, we mow the entire
park at various times during the week throughout the season. If you are camping with
us during the week, keep this in mind. All mowing days are subject to change due to
inclement weather or holidays.

Pet Policies

- Pets are welcome at Eagle Ridge, but we want all our guests to enjoy their stay, so please respect the following rules if you bring your pet:
- All pets must be on a leash and under the owner's control, at all times with no exceptions. This means the pet is NOT tied outside or left unattended at any time.
- Maximum of 2 pets, proof of vaccination status is required at check in.
- No aggressive pets will be allowed.
- YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET IMMEDIATELY.
 - Dispose of your pets' waste in the dumpster. Not in the bathroom trash, do not throw it into the woods or fire pit. Clean up fees will be assessed if others have to clean up after your pet,
 - Do not walk dogs in the area between the campground and the road.
 - When walking pets in the tent area, you must still clean up after them.
- There will only be one warning given for pet behavior or failure to clean up after them, if there is a second complaint you will be asked to leave.
- Do not take your pets in the bathrooms or showers.

Management reserves the right to evict or refuse entry to any person who has evidenced a disregard for the rules without a refund. Guests and visitors agree to use the campground and Festival area at their own risk. The management and owners are not responsible for damage, injury or loss to persons, pets, or property.
